America's Gateway to the World

Meridian's story unfolds at the intersection of history, architecture, and diplomacy.

Our stately campus in the heart of Washington, D.C., features two architectural masterpieces: Meridian House and White-Meyer House. Designed in the early 20th century by John Russell Pope—the visionary architect behind the Jefferson Memorial and the National Archives—these homes once served as residences for two U.S. ambassadors and are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
